- Before you dispose of a Spa Table or any old appliance, **render it inoperative.** Unplug the Spa Table / appliance and cut off the entire power cord. Dispose of the power cord and the plug immediately.

1.2 Signal words

⚠ DANGER! indicates a hazardous situation which, if ignored, will result in death or serious injury.

⚠ WARNING! indicates a hazardous situation which, if ignored, could result in death or serious injury.

⚠ CAUTION! indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury.

NOTICE! indicates a hazardous situation which, if ignored, may result in damage to the spa table / appliance.

1.3 Safety instructions

⚠ DANGER!

To reduce the risk of electrocution:

1. Non-compliance with the instructions in this manual endangers the operator's and customer's health and life and / or can damage the Spa Table.
2. All electrical work to connect the MLW to the mains must be carried out by a qualified professional. Do not modify the energy supply. The connection must be carried out in accordance with the current local and legal regulations. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!**
3. The current voltage and the power frequency of the power supply **must** correspond to the values indicated on the rating plate.
4. Do not make any changes or manipulations to the MLW and / or its power supply (mains cable, mains plug). In case of unauthorized changes or manipulations, **any** warranty of the Gharieni Group GmbH is excluded.
5. **Do not connect** the MLW to the mains if the Spa Table itself or the power cable or the plug are visibly damaged. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!**
6. The power cable must not be under the MLW except Gharieni Group GmbH expressly allows it. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!**
7. The power cord must not be placed close to the actuators during connection or repositioning as it can be damaged while operating the actuators. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!**
8. Never roll the MLW over the power cord; otherwise you can damage the power cord permanently.
9. When retracting the castors, the power cord must not be under the MLW; otherwise, the adjustable feet may squeeze the power cord and cause permanent damage. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!**

10. Never try to repair the MLW yourself. If the MLW does not operate properly, please contact Gharieni Group GmbH or the dealer you purchased the appliance at. Original spare parts should be used only.
11. If repair or replacement of the power supply cable and / or the power supply plug is necessary, always commission a qualified specialist (electrical engineer) or a customer service authorized by Gharieni Group GmbH. Never repair or replace them yourself.
RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
12. **Always** unplug the MLW if it is not used for a longer period.
13. Always disconnect the MLW from the mains before cleaning and / or maintenance. RIKS OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
14. **Never** pull the power supply cable to unplug the MLW. Always use the power plug itself to unplug the MLW. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
15. **Never** touch the power plug, the power switch, or other electrical components with wet or damp hands. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
16. Do not place or store the MLW close to a source of liquid, such as a bathtub, a shower, or a washbasin. There is danger that the MLW may meet splashed water. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!


To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire, or injury to persons:

1. Use only a properly secured safety socket with the appropriate mains voltage and power frequency. See technical data and rating plate.
2. **The electric components must not meet water or other liquids.**

3. Check all cables regularly and contact the customer service when any cable is in improper condition. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
4. The MLW must not stand on the power cord. Ensure that the cord is not damaged when moving the MLW. Do not step on the cord. Do not stretch the cord.
5. Always ensure that the power cord is not bent or squeezed during installation.
6. **Do not** use any extension cords, multiple sockets, or adapters.
RISK OF FIRE!
7. **Do not** open the housings of the electric control panels! RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
8. Liquids **must not** get into the electric control panels! RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!

9. Do not use water or any other liquids while carrying out any application. Do not spill water or any other liquids over, on or into the MLW. Should you spill any water, **immediately** pull the mains plug and dry the MLW thoroughly. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
10. **Never** immerse any parts of the MLW in water. When cleaning the MLW, make sure that no water penetrates the MLW or its housing. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
11. **For MLW Neo Soft only**: To prevent damage caused by heat, a gap must be left between the backrest and the seat upholstery (see illustration below) when the heating system (optional equipment) is used for longer periods, so that the two heating elements do not touch each other and can add up. RISK OF BURNS DUE TO HEAT ACCUMULATION!

12. **People with acute pain, venous disorders, low blood pressure, inflammatory processes and other medical conditions that make heat applications or this form of client positioning questionable, must always consult a doctor before use.**
13. **Never use the MLW on people who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.**
14. Operate or store the MLW in a dry environment **only**.
15. Close supervision is necessary when the MLW is used by, on, or near children or invalids.
16. Use the MLW only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments / accessories not recommended by Gharieni Group GmbH.
17. Never operate the MLW if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been damaged or if it has become wet. Return the MLW to an authorized aftersales service for examination and repair.
18. In case of defects or malfunctions of the wellness table, contact customer service **immediately**. Use of the wellness table **must** be discontinued until the problem has been solved to avoid further damage to property and persons.

19. Regularly remove any dust build-up from the mains plug, the safety socket and all electrical plug connections, e.g. with a commercially available vacuum cleaner. RISK OF FIRE!
20. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
21. Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
22. Do not use the MLW outdoors.
23. Do not allow any unauthorized person to operate the MLW!
24. Use the MLW only on a level surface.
25. **Do not place** any objects or liquids on the MLW. The Spa Table as well as the material can be damaged thereby. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK! RISK OF DAMAGE!
26. Any repairs and maintenance work must be carried out by qualified professionals authorized by the Gharieni Group GmbH **only!** RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK! RISK OF FIRE!
27. **Do not use** a steam cleaner for cleaning. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!
28. **Never** rest or stand on any part of the lying surface or of the supporting structure of the MLW. Do not exert strong physical forces on these components; otherwise you can damage the supporting structure permanently. RISK OF TIPPING! RISK OF BREAKAGE! RISK OF INJURY!
29. Persons, animals or body parts of persons and animals **must not** be positioned between the base and the upper structure. RISK OF CRUSHING!
30. Ensure that no parts of the body or items are between the parts of the MLW while adjusting the lying position. RISK OF CRUSHING!
31. **Do not** use the supporting structure as a footrest. RISK OF CRUSHING!
32. Make sure that the MLW always stands on its fixed feet. There is a RISK OF ROLLING AWAY when merely standing on the movable castors!
33. **Never** extend the castors while any person is on the MLW. Do not move the MLW on its castors if any person or load is on the MLW; otherwise you damage the substructure or castors.
34. The MLW must **never** be used (neither with nor without castors) for to transport persons or heavy loads. RISK OF INJURY! RISK OF DAMAGE!
35. While unpacking, the packaging materials should be kept away from children, pets, or persons with reduced mental capabilities. RISK OF INJURY! CHOKING HAZARD!
36. Always keep children and pets away from the MLW.
37. Children must not play with the MLW or its single components.

38. The MLW is not intended to be operated by persons with reduced physical, sensory, and mental capabilities or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they are supervised or instructed concerning the use of the MLW and do understand the danger resulting thereof.

NOTICE!

1. The special pallet the MLW is delivered on has cut-outs. Upon delivery, the adjustable feet of the MLW stand in the respective cut-outs to prevent the Spa Table from inadvertent movement. Therefore, **it is essential to lift the MLW vertically from the special pallet using all four special carrying aids.** Non-compliance of this instruction can damage the adjustable feet of the MLW seriously. RISK OF DAMAGE!
2. For safety reasons, the MLW moves only while pressing a button of the hand controls or the optional foot controls. When you stop pressing, all moving operation will stop immediately.
3. **Never** rest, stand, or kneel on any part of the lying surface of the MLW. Do not exert strong physical forces on the lying surface; otherwise you can damage the upholstery permanently. RISK OF DAMAGE!
4. Do not lean, stand, or sit on the armrests or headrest; otherwise you can damage the armrests or headrest permanently! RISK OF DAMAGE!
5. The maximum load capacity of the armrests is 25 kg.
6. To prevent unauthorized use of the MLW, **always** lock the drives manually using the hand control or the optional foot control when leaving the treatment room. No automatic locking is set as standard. You can decide for yourself whether to change this. Manual locking **does not** affect the currently running heating cycle and has **no effect** on the operation of the heating system. The heating cycle currently in process is **not affected** by automatic locking.
7. The rating plate must not be removed or made illegible.
Non-compliance will expire the warranty!

2. Intended Use

- ❖ Read the instructions very carefully and **only** operate the Spa Table in its intended use as described to protect you and your customers from danger.
- ❖ The MLW is a versatile Spa Table. You can use it for e.g. cosmetic applications or full body massages in dry rooms, etc.
Any other use is not permitted and affects your warranty claims.
The Gharieni Spa Table MLW is **no** medical device.
- ❖ The MLW is **only** intended for use in closed rooms with defined ambient conditions. See chapter 24. CONDITIONS FOR TRANSPORT, STORAGE AND OPERATION.

★ **No liability for personal injury or material damage will be accepted if these instructions are not followed.**

3. Scope of Delivery

- 1 SPA TABLE MLW NEO / MLW NEO SOFT in desired design and equipment
- 1 HAND CONTROL
- 4 SPECIAL CARRYING AIDS
- 1 INSTRUCTION MANUAL

i If you have purchased additional optional accessories for your Spa Table, these are also included in the scope of delivery.

4. Preliminary remarks

- ❖ The Gharieni Spa Table MLW is subject to the highest safety and quality standards.
- ❖ Before initial operation, make sure that all parts are present and show no visible damage.
- ❖ Make sure that the socket for the treatment table is properly grounded and has the correct mains voltage and mains frequency, see rating plate.



Before assembly, ensure that sufficient space is provided for the MLW so that it does not bump into anything even when fully extended.

5. Delivery and unpacking of the MLW

5.1 Delivery

- ❖ The MLW is delivered and packed in a cardboard on a special pallet (s. fig. below). The MLW is in complete horizontal position and the upholstery is installed.



DELIVERY BY GHARIENI GROUP GMBH:

If the MLW is delivered by Gharieni Group GmbH, the driver will **help** with the installation of the MLW and will also dispose of the packaging material and the special pallet.


DELIVERY BY AN EXTERNAL FORWARDER:

If the MLW is delivered by an external forwarder, the MLW is normally **only** delivered. In this case, you must dispose of the packaging material and the special pallet on your own responsibility.

5.2 Unpacking

⚠ WARNING! While unpacking, the packaging materials should be kept away from children and pets. **RISK OF INJURY! CHOKING HAZARD!**

- ❖ The MLW is delivered and packed in a cardboard on a special pallet (s. fig. below).

1. Cut the packaging tapes (**A**) with scissors and remove them.
2. **DO NOT open** the upper cardboard (**B**) **but** lift it carefully and vertically as a whole from the MLW and from the special pallet (**C**). For this purpose, you will need two persons (one person each on the short sides / **D** of the cardboard).
3. Dispose of the cardboard properly.
4. Now you can move the MLW from the special pallet; **strictly observe** the instructions given in chapter 6.2 TRANSPORT / SPECIAL CARRYING AIDS and chapter 6.2.1 USE OF THE SPECIAL CARRYING AIDS when doing so.

6. Assembly and transport of the MLW

6.1 Assembly

The MLW is usually delivered fully assembled, so no assembly work is necessary. In **exceptional cases**, necessary assembly work will be carried out by the deliverer on site.

- i** Before installation, ensure that there is sufficient free space for the MLW relevant to its total length.

⚠ WARNING! On versions with the optional heating system, the cables are located between the upholstery and the metal frame (depending on model). **Removal of the upholstery must be carried out by authorized professionals only!**

6.2 Transport

- i** A transport of the MLW can be severely affected to some extent due to unfavourable environment conditions. Such unfavourable environmental conditions are e.g. narrow doors, narrow corners behind doors, narrow corridors, narrow staircases, spiral staircases etc. The weight of the MLW is at least 130 kg; the length is approx. 203 cm and the width including the upholstery is 76 cm / 85 cm or 92 cm¹; thus, the manoeuvrability of the MLW is limited.

EXTENDABLE / RETRACTABLE CASTORS:

- ❖ The MLW has a special construction that extends the retractable castors so that the table can be moved (s. chapter 6.2.2 EXTENDABLE / RETRACTABLE CASTORS).
- i** In case of unfavourable soil conditions, such as a wavy, uneven floor or tiled floor with wide and deep joints, the MLW must not be moved on the extendable castors, otherwise the Spa Table may be seriously damaged. In this case you must use the special carrying aids supplied (s. fig. below) to move or transport the MLW.

SPECIAL CARRYING AIDS:

- i** You **also** need the special carrying aids (s. fig. above) **to lift the MLW from the special pallet**. The proper use of the special carrying aids is described below in chapter 6.2.1.
- i** You **need 4 persons** to move or transport the MLW using the special carrying aids.

6.2.1 Use of the special carrying aids

⚠ DANGER! After transport, while putting down the MLW, the power cord must not be under the Spa Table; otherwise the adjustable feet may squeeze the power cord and cause permanent damage while putting down the MLW or when retracting the castors.

⚠ WARNING! RISK OF CRUSHING your toes / feet while lowering or moving the MLW.

NOTICE! The special pallet the MLW is delivered on has recesses. Upon delivery, the adjustable feet of the MLW stand in the respective recesses to prevent the Spa Table from slipping. **Therefore, it is essential to lift the MLW vertically from the special pallet** using all four special carrying aids. Failure to follow this instruction can seriously damage the adjustable feet of the MLW. RISK OF DAMAGE!



i Figures similar: All following figures serve as examples only.

1. To move the MLW from the special pallet, you must raise it first. Plug in the MLW to do this. Then press the corresponding push button of the hand control which is on one side on a suspension mechanism / **button T 1**, s. fig. in chapter 11.1 HAND CONTROL WITH MEMORY FUNCTION resp. chapter 11.2 HAND CONTROL WITHOUT MEMORY FUNCTION.




2. You must set the backrest in upright position before you use the special carrying aids. To do this, press the corresponding push button of the hand control (**button T 2**, s. fig. in chapter 11.1 HAND CONTROL WITH MEMORY FUNCTION resp. chapter 11.2 HAND CONTROL WITHOUT MEMORY FUNCTION).
3. **Then unplug the MLW again.**
4. Lift the lower casing (**A**) by hand (s. fig. below).



5. Insert the special carrying aids (**C**) into the four intended openings (**B**) in the adjustable feet (2 at the front, two at the back) and screw them tight (s. fig. below).



6. You need **4 persons** to move the MLW to its final site.
7. It is essential to **lift** the MLW **vertically** from the special pallet using **all four** special carrying aids. Otherwise you damage the adjustable feet.
8. Carry or transport the MLW **using all four special carrying aids only**; otherwise you can damage the MLW irreparably.
9. Store the carrying aids in a safe place. If the MLW must be carried or transported at a later point of time (e.g. when moving), it is only possible when using the four special carrying aids.
10. If the floor is not level, you must ensure proper stability of the MLW by adjusting the four adjustable feet (**D** /s. fig. below). After you have adjusted the feet, they must be secured by tightening the respective lock nut (**E**) (see picture below).

NOTICE! When you have placed the MLW in a suitable position providing sufficient free space, remove the special carrying aids and store them at a safe place for future use.

NOTICE! If the floor is not level, you **must** ensure proper stability of the MLW by adjusting the four adjustable feet.

6.2.2 Extendable / retractable castors

⚠ DANGER! When retracting the castors, the power cord must not be under the MLW; otherwise, the adjustable feet may squeeze the power cord and cause permanent damage. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK!

⚠ DANGER! Never roll the MLW over the power cord; otherwise you can damage the power cord permanently.

⚠ WARNING! Always ensure that the MLW stands on its solid adjustable feet. If the MLW stands on its mobile castors only, there is a RISK OF ROLLING AWAY!

⚠ WARNING! RISK OF CRUSHING your toes / feet while lowering or moving the MLW.

⚠ WARNING! **Never** extend the castors while any person is on the MLW.

⚠ WARNING! The MLW **must never** be used (neither with nor without castors) for carrying or transporting persons or heavy loads. RISK OF INJURY! RISK OF DAMAGE!

USE OF THE MECHANICALLY EXTENDABLE CASTORS:


1. Set the backrest in upright position (**button T 2** of the hand control / s. fig. in chapter 11.1 HAND CONTROL WITH MEMORY FUNCTION resp. chapter 11.2 HAND CONTROL WITHOUT MEMORY FUNCTION).




2. Lift the cover plate (**A**) of the upper casing vertically and remove it (s. fig. below).



3. The lever (**B**) to extend the castors mechanically is at the bottom of the now open casing (s. fig. below).



4. Pull the lever (**B**) towards you to extend the castors. Thereby, you must overcome a resistant point.



5. The castors are now extended.

i **Before moving the MLW**, unplug it, roll up the power cord properly and store the power cord in such a way, that you cannot roll over it when moving the MLW. Do not retract the castors unless the MLW stands at its desired site and you have checked that the cables are not located underneath the MLW.

6. Now you can roll the MLW to another position.
7. Proceed in reverse order to retract the castors. Make sure to align the recess (C)² of the cover plate (A) properly.

7. Rating plate

- ❖ The rating plate is in the casing under the cover plate on the head side of the MLW (s. **fig. 1** and **fig. 2**).
- ❖ The lever (**B** / **fig. 2**) is intended for the operation of the extendable / retractable castors (s. chapter 6.2.2 EXTENDABLE / RETRACTABLE CASTORS)

i Do not make the rating plate illegible! Do not remove the rating plate!
Non-compliance will expire the warranty!

i Figures similar: All following figures serve as examples only.

1. Set the backrest in upright position (**button T 2** of the hand control, s. fig. in chapter 11.1 HAND CONTROL WITH MEMORY FUNCTION, resp. chapter 11.2 HAND CONTROL WITHOUT MEMORY FUNCTION).



2. You must remove the cover plate (**A** / s. **fig. 1**) to gain access to the rating plate (**D** / s. **fig. 2**).
3. Make sure to align the recess (**C**)³ of the cover plate (**A**) properly when replacing the cover plate (s. **fig. 1**).
4. The first information on the rating plate (**D**) is the serial number





This makes it easier for you to identify the information of the rating plate (e.g. the serial number of the Spa Table) to provide the required information to the customer service.</p> <p>On the cover page of this instruction manual is an empty field in which you can enter the serial number of your Spa Table. This way you have the serial number always at hand.</p> |

8. QR-Code



In case of service, you can scan the QR code using the OCR scan function of a suitable device (e.g. a smartphone). A form will then open via the Internet browser of your device, which already automatically contains the serial number of your MLW. Please describe your problem there and enter your data. You can attach a file from your device memory or take a photo with your device and attach it. To do this, tap on the "Select file" button. A window with options will then open. The appearance of this window may differ from the illustration, depending on your device and operating system.

After you have confirmed that you have read our data protection guidelines by marking the box at the end of the form, the form with all the entries you have made is immediately sent to our customer service department by clicking on "Send".

- ❖ The QR code is located on the head side of the MLW Neo / MLW Neo Soft in the housing under the cover plate.

- i** To gain access to the RATING PLATE or the QR-CODE, you must place the backrest in an upright position (see the figure in chapter 7. RATING PLATE / button T 2 of the hand control) and keep it pressed, (s. fig. in chapter 11.1 HAND CONTROL WITH MEMORY FUNCTION resp. chapter 11.2 HAND CONTROL WITHOUT MEMORY FUNCTION).





10. Operation of the MLW

 **WARNING!** Do not carry out any physical force to the components named before (instructions are not depending on the adjustment of the lying surface). Failure to do so can cause permanent damage to the construction of the MLW. RISK OF TIPPING! RISK OF BREAKAGE! RISK OF INJURY!

10.1 Characteristics

- ❖ The MLW is a versatile Spa Table. You can use it for e.g. cosmetic applications or full body massages in dry rooms.
- ❖ The Gharieni MLW is a Spa Table which is equipped with four actuators. With these actuators you can easily adjust the desired positions electrically using the hand controls or the optional foot controls.
- ❖ The MLW is available in various widths (SMALL / MEDIUM / LARGE / s. chapter 10.2 MODEL VERSIONS).
- ❖ Working height, backrest, inclination of the seat section, and leg section are electrically adjustable (s. chapter 11. ADJUSTMENTS OF THE MLW).
- ❖ The **areas of the MLW that are not powered by an actuator** (armrests / headrest) can be adjusted pneumatically using a gas pressure spring by means of a lever.
- ❖ The armrests are pneumatically adjustable (s. chapter 10.7 ARMRESTS).
- ❖ The headrest is pneumatically adjustable (s. chapter 10.6 HEADREST).
- ❖ Frequently used treatment positions can be saved using two free-choice memory locations on the hand control or on the optional foot control (s. chapter 11.7 MEMORY FUNCTIONS OF THE HAND CONTROL, resp. chapter 12. FOOT CONTROL).
Please note: This is only possible with the hand control with memory function!
- ❖ The hand control without memory function does not allow memory positions to be saved and recalled and there are no permanently saved positions.
- ❖ The maximum lifting capacity of the MLW is 250 kg.
- ❖ The maximum load capacity of the lying surface is 300 kg.

10.5 Gas pressure springs

- ❖ The armrests as well as the headrest can be adjusted pneumatically using a gas pressure spring by means of a lever.
- ❖ If you carry out any setting by means of the lever of the gas pressure spring, you **only** need to operate the lever **when lowering** the armrests or headrest.
- ❖ Carry out a pulling movement upwards (**without operation of the respective lever**) to **lift** an armrest and / or the headrest again.

10.6 Headrest





- ❖ The upholstery of the standard headrest is equipped with a nose slot usable when carrying out back-massages. For this purpose, the headrest is equipped with a separate upholstery part, which can be removed (s. **fig. 6**).
- ❖ The optionally available multifunctional headrest is equipped with a nose slot as well.
- ❖ Using a gel cushion (s. **fig. 7**, optionally available at Gharieni) on the headrest upholstery can additionally support the face of the person to be treated (see also chapter 21.2 GEL CUSHION FOR NOSE SLOTS).

10.8 Legrest

- ❖ The seat area must be raised for this (s. chapter 11.4 ADJUSTMENT OF THE INCLINATION OF THE SEAT SECTION).

10.9 Backrest

- ❖ The backrest of the MLW can be adjusted electrically (s. chapter 11.4 ADJUSTMENT OF THE BACKREST).
- ❖ The inclination of the backrest can also be adjusted using the appropriate button of the hand control or of the foot control or of the foot control with Bluetooth (s. chapter 12. FOOT CONTROL and chapter 12.1 FOOT CONTROL WITH BLUETOOTH).

11. Adjustments of the MLW

-  The electrical adjustments of the MLW are made with a hand control.
-  **Optionally**, most of the electrical adjustments can also be made using a foot control or a foot control with Bluetooth (s. chapter 12. FOOT CONTROL and chapter 12.1 FOOT CONTROL WITH BLUETOOTH).
-  The pneumatic adjustments of the MLW (headrest / armrests) are made using a gas spring operating by a lever.



For safety reasons, the MLW moves only while pressing a button of the hand control or the respective optional foot control.
When you stop pressing, all moving operation will stop immediately.

11.1 Hand control with memory function


- ❖ You can control each of the four actuators by pressing and holding down the corresponding push button.
- ❖ You can also set and save two memory positions.
How to save certain positions is described under MEMORY FUNCTIONS OF THE HAND CONTROL (s. chapter 11.7).
- ❖ It is also possible to recall the four permanently saved positions.
- ❖ The hand control with memory function has 12 buttons.
- ❖ The hand control can be connected flexibly on both sides of the bed This is made possible by connections on both sides underneath the upholstery (s. chapter 15. BOTH SIDE CONNECTIONS FOR HAND / FOOT CONTROL).
- ❖ The working height, backrest, seat tilt and leg section (buttons T 1 - T 4) are adjusted using a double-tap system.
This serves for safety. A movement that is associated with danger is made intentionally by this.

For the direction of movement, please note the arrow symbols and the number of dots in the upper section of the hand control.

Simply pressing a button and keeping it pressed will cause a movement upwards.

Double pressing (double-tap system) and holding down causes a movement in the opposite direction.

Saving the manually savable positions and deactivating the locking function is also done via the double-tap system.



- ❖ The currently running heating cycle is **not affected** by an automatic locking. A manual lock also **does not affect** the currently running heating cycle and has **no effect on the operation of the heating system**.

VARIOUS AUTOMATIC LOCKING TIMES:

Various automatic locking times can be set.

To get feedback on the currently set automatic locking time, press buttons T 9 and T 10 once simultaneously.

Feedback on the currently set automatic locking time is given as follows via flashing of all LEDs of the hand control and several beeps, depending on the automatic locking time:

- automatic locking after **30** minutes:
1 beep and **1 time** flashing of all LEDs of the hand control
- automatic locking after **60** minutes:
2 beeps and **2 times** flashing of all LEDs of the hand control
- automatic locking after **90** minutes:
3 beeps and **3 times** flashing of all LEDs of the hand control
- automatic locking after **120** minutes:
4 beeps and **4 times** flashing of all LEDs of the hand control
- **no** automatic locking:
5 beeps and **5 times** flashing of all LEDs of the hand control

To change from one automatic locking time to the next, please press both buttons T 9 and T 10 simultaneously and keep them pressed for about 6 seconds.

All LEDs flash and a corresponding beep is sounded to provide feedback on the currently set automatic locking time, followed by a change to the next automatic locking time.

Example:


30 minutes is set as the automatic locking time.

You want to change to the automatic locking time 60 minutes.

Press the corresponding buttons simultaneously and keep them pressed for approx. 6 seconds until feedback about the now set automatic locking time 60 minutes is given through flashing of all LEDs of the hand control and beeps.

The automatic locking time is always changed in this sequence:

30 min. - 60 min. - 90 min. - 120 min. - **no automatic locking.**



Buttons T 9 + T 10 (F3)


LOCKING THE DRIVES MANUALLY:

1. To lock the drives manually, press the LOCK button (**T 11** of the hand control) and **keep it pressed** for about 2 seconds.
2. Successful locking is confirmed by an acoustic signal and the LED above the button on the hand control also lights up.
3. The drives are now locked.



UNLOCKING THE DRIVES MANUALLY:

1. To unlock the drives, press the LOCK button (**T 11**) on the hand control **twice in quick succession** (double-tap) and keep it pressed for about 2 seconds.
2. The successful unlocking is confirmed by an acoustic signal and the LED above the button on the hand control is switched off.
3. The drives are now **unlocked**.



12. Foot control (optional equipment)

- ❖ The foot control (see figure) can be connected in addition to the hand control and enables the basic functions to be controlled, saving, and recalling of manually saved memory positions, **recalling the permanently saved entry position and the operation of the lock function and the optional heating system.**
- ❖ The foot control consists of a left and a right part and a middle part (see figure).
- ❖ The foot control can be flexibly connected on both sides of the bed.
This is made possible by connections on both sides of the bed underneath the upholstery (see chapter 15. CONNECTIONS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BED FOR HAND / FOOT CONTROL).
- ❖ Pressing the **individual** pedals causes only one actuator to be adjusted back/forth (working height or backrest / see figure below).
- ❖ Saving and moving to the manually saved memory positions, moving to the permanently saved entry position, the activation/de-activation of the locking function and the operation of the heating system is made using a combination of **several** pedals of the foot control.
- ❖ The operation is performed in a double-tap system, as with the hand control. This is for safety reasons. A movement that is associated with danger is performed intentionally in this way.


For the direction of movement please note the arrow symbols and the number of dots on the labels of the left and right foot control section.

By simply pressing a pedal and keeping it pressed, a movement is made upwards.

By pressing twice (double-tap system) and keeping it pressed, a movement in the opposite direction is made.

The two memory positions can also be saved manually using the double-tap system (see chapter 11.7 MEMORY FUNCTIONS OF THE HAND CONTROL).

NOTICE! For safety reasons, the MLW moves only while pressing a button of the optional foot control. When you stop pressing, all moving operation will stop immediately.

12.1 Foot control with Bluetooth (optional equipment)

- ❖ A foot control with Bluetooth can be connected as an option in addition to the hand control.
- ❖ The foot control enables the adjustment of the basic functions and the approach of the two fixed positions P1 to P4.
In addition, the heating system can be operated, the bed can be locked and unlocked, and the bed software can be reset.
- ❖ On delivery, the foot control is already connected to the control of the bed. If the lounge cannot be adjusted via the Bluetooth foot control, you may have to change the batteries.
- ❖ The operation is done in the double-tap system, as with the hand control. This is for safety reasons. A movement that is associated with danger is made consciously by this.

By simply pressing a button and keeping it pressed, a movement is made upwards.

Pressing a button twice (double-tap system) and keeping it pressed makes a movement in the opposite direction.

Some functions are also set by double-tapping.

- When purchasing a MLW, the hand control is included as standard. Optionally, for an additional charge, the foot control with Bluetooth can be purchased.


NOTICE! The Bluetooth foot control is battery-operated.

With normal use (a few minutes daily), a battery life of 3-4 years can be expected. It is not necessary to pair the Bluetooth foot control with the couch control again when replacing the batteries.

NOTICE! If the Bluetooth foot control does not work despite changing the batteries, please contact our customer service.

NOTICE! The Bluetooth foot control may have to be woken up by pressing any button before use, as it switches to sleep mode after approx. three seconds.

NOTICE! To switch on the heating system with the first heating level, to change to the next heating level or to switch off the heating system, the buttons of the Bluetooth foot control must be held down for approx. one second.

13. Heating system (optional equipment)

❖ The lying surface of MLW can be heated to maximize the treatment comfort. The heating system is a pre-programmed and fully automatic heating system which allows a comfortable operation. The intelligent heating system is integrated into the upholstery of the MLW and works with modern microprocessor technology. The heating system for the MLW is optionally available for an additional charge.

i Due to the pre-programmed microchip, you **only** must switch on the heating system with the “On” - button to start the heating system with the lowest heat/power level. The heating cycle is fully automatic and switches off automatically after the total time (90 minutes) has elapsed.

➤ s. chapter 13.1 OPERATION

i Various automatic locking times can be set, s. chapter 11.6 LOCKING FUNCTION. The currently running heating cycle is **not affected** by this.

i Even a **manual** locking **does not affect** the currently running heating cycle and **has no effect on the operation of the heating system**.





NOTICE! The currently active heating level is displayed via a LED (diode) above the button of the hand control or in the centre section of the optional foot control. The frequency of the pulse for visualisation varies according to the active heating level.

 **WARNING!**


1. **Do not use** the option heating system if your customer
 - has got a pacemaker.
 - is pregnant.
 - is affected by thrombosis.
 - suffers from pain due to unknown reasons.
2. Apply to healthy people **only**.
3. If the treatment is ended prematurely, the heating system must be switched off by pressing the corresponding button on the hand control or on the respective optional foot control to prevent heat accumulation.
4. Disconnect the MLW from the mains when it is not used for a longer period, e.g. during the night.

 **WARNING!** Never use the MLW on people who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

 **WARNING!** If the bed is equipped with the heating system (optional), the cables are located between the upholstery and the underframe (depending on the model). **The upholstery may only be removed by persons authorized by the Gharieni Group GmbH.**

13.1 Operation

- ❖ The heating system is operated using the  button of the hand control.
- ❖ For operation using the optional foot control or the foot control with Bluetooth, see chapter 12. FOOT CONTROL (OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT) and chapter 12.1 FOOT CONTROL WITH BLUETOOTH.



POWER ON:

- ❖ Use this button to switch **on** the heating system.

The heating system comes with three heat / power levels.

To quickly heat up the bed's surface before starting treatment, we recommend setting the heating system to level 2; only in exceptional cases to level 3 (highest level).





- i** Please refer to the chart below to find information on how to operate the heating system.
- i** After a total time of **90 minutes** the heating system switches off **automatically**; regardless of the set heating level.
- ❖ This process is pre-programmed.



POWER OFF:

- ❖ Using this button you also switch **off** the heating system.

There are three heat / power levels to choose from:

NOTICE! The Bluetooth foot control may have to be woken up by pressing any button before use, as it switches to sleep mode after approx. three seconds.

NOTICE! To switch on the heating system with the first heating level, to change to the next heating level or to switch off the heating system, the buttons of the Bluetooth foot control must be held down for approx. one second.

14. Audio-Relax headrest (optional equipment)

The AUDIO RELAX HEADREST for the MLW is also optionally available for an additional charge. The AUDIO RELAX HEADREST is equipped with integrated speakers and provides a pleasant relaxing sound experience with greatest comfort.

This option supports optimal relaxing of your customers and adds an individual touch to your massages. Two speakers laterally installed in the headrest support the massage by a unique experience of sound without harassing your customer. The volume is **not** intended to fill rooms with sound.

15. Connections for hand / foot control on both sides

- ❖ At the head end, underneath the upholstery, there is a connection for a hand control and/or foot control on each side of the bed (see figure below). This allows excellent flexibility.
You can, for example, also connect two hand controls to the bed.
- ❖ When not in use, the connections can be protected against external influences by means of a cap.



16. Magnetic folding tray (optional equipment)

- ❖ A magnetic folding tray (s. fig. below) for the MLW is optionally available for an additional charge.
- ❖ The magnetic folding tray is mounted underneath the nose slot of the headrest. After use, the magnetic folding tray is folded up to save space and secured via an invisible magnet.



- ❖ The magnetic folding tray can be used to place accessories (e.g., potpourri, etc.) underneath the nose slot (s. fig. below) to enhance the well-being of your customer.



⚠ CAUTION! Always ensure that the magnetic folding tray is **folded up** during facials. Otherwise you can bump your legs, knees, etc. **RISK OF INJURY!**

NOTICE! Do not lean against the magnetic folding tray! Do not stand or sit on the magnetic folding tray; otherwise you can damage the magnetic folding tray permanently! **RISK OF DAMAGE!**

17. Multifunctional headrest (optional equipment)

- ❖ A multifunctional headrest is available for the MLW at an extra charge.
- ❖ Depending on your wishes, a round face rest or a U-shaped face rest can be used.
- ❖ **Both face rests have a nose slot.**
- ❖ To get the nose slot for the round face rest, please remove the separate upholstery part.
- ❖ This multifunctional headrest offers full flexibility for every need.



18. Reset and Initialization

If you notice that when recalling the memory positions you have saved, these bed positions are no longer reached or that one or more bed functions no longer be adjusted correctly, the software of the MLW must be reinitialized.


To call up the bed positions you have saved correctly again, the following steps must be carried out:

PLEASE PROCEED AS FOLLOWS:

Reset:

Press the lower two buttons of the respective hand control (s. fig. below) **simultaneously** and hold them down for approx. 10 seconds until the signal tone ends.


Now move the actuators as described below (initialization).



Initialization:

1. The **backrest actuator** must be set to **max.** position. The backrest must have an angle of 75° to the seat! (**button T 2** of the hand control / s. fig. 12).
2. The **other actuators** must be set to **min.** position; that means:
 - a. The height actuator (working height) must be set to its lowest setting! (**button T 1** of the hand control / s. fig. 12).
 - b. The inclination actuator (thigh-area) must be level to the leg section (calf-area), i.e. it must be adjusted horizontally.
Caution! Keep pressing **button T 3** of the hand control with memory function, resp. of the hand control without memory function (s. fig. 12 and 13) **until the actuator is switched off**.
 - c. The actuator of the leg section must also be set to min., i.e. keep pressing the **button T 4** of the hand control with memory function, resp. of the hand control without memory function (s. fig. 12 and 13) until this actuator is also **audibly switched off**.

❖ Initialization is complete when the described positions are reached



- i** The adjustment (initialization) must be carried out manually, i.e. each actuator must be moved **individually** by you to the end position.



When the final positions are reached, please keep pressing the push buttons for additional 2 to 3 seconds.

⚠ WARNING! This calibration (initializing) **must be** made manually, i.e. each actuator **must be moved individually**. **Do not use any buttons of the memory function when initializing the software!**

19. Cleaning and maintenance of the MLW

⚠ WARNING Always disconnect the MLW from the mains (unplug) before cleaning and maintenance. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK! RISK OF FIRE!

⚠ WARNING! Regularly remove any dust build-up from the mains plug, the safety socket and all electrical plug connections, e.g. with a commercially available vacuum cleaner. RISK OF FIRE!

⚠ WARNING! Always ensure that water or other liquids **cannot get** into the housing and the fittings of the MLW or into the hand control. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK! RISK OF FIRE!

- ❖ **Do not wear** any arm and finger decoration such as rings or bracelets while carrying out any cleaning or maintenance operations. Otherwise you can scratch and damage the upholstery and / or the material of the casing of the MLW unintentionally.
- ❖ Use water or a mild cleaning agent which is suitable for the material **only**.
- ❖ **Do not use** extremely hot water for cleaning of the MLW.
- ❖ **Do not use** any hard sponges, scouring pads or floor clothes.
- ❖ **Do not use** any aggressive cleaning agents such as scouring powders, floor cleaners, etc.
- ❖ **Do not use** any dishwashing detergents.
- ❖ **Do not use** any solvents or bleaching agents.
- ❖ **Do not use** any essential oils.

NOTICE! Damages of the upholstery and / or of the material of the casing resulting from the use of unsuitable cleaning detergents **is not covered by the guarantee or the warranty!**

19.1 Cleaning and care of the polyurethane (PU) upholstery

- ❖ Clean the PU **only** with a soft cloth with a small amount of a detergent suitable for this material (also available from Gharieni: see chapter 23. UPHOLSTERY CARE AND CLEANING AGENTS).

NOTICE! Depending on the chosen configuration, the upholstery of the MLW can be made of PU (polyurethane). This material can be cleaned on a cloth with some detergent, which must be suitable for polyurethane.

19.2 Cleaning and care of the artificial leather

- ❖ Clean the artificial leather **only** with a soft cloth with a small amount of a detergent suitable for this material (also available from Gharieni: see chapter 23. UPHOLSTERY CARE AND CLEANING AGENTS).

NOTICE! The upholstery of the MLW can also be made of artificial leather or Ferrari Stamskin Top artificial leather. This material can be cleaned with a cloth with some detergent, which must be suitable for artificial leather.

19.3 Cleaning the housing and the fittings

- ❖ Clean the housing and the fittings only with a damp soft cloth or a soft sponge and some cleaning agent, e.g. Microzid Sensitive (see chapter 23. UPHOLSTERY CARE AND CLEANING AGENTS).

WARNING! Always ensure that water or other liquids never penetrate the housing, the fittings or the hand controls or foot controls of the MLW. **RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK! FIRE HAZARD!**

19.4 Cover of the upholstery

- ❖ The upholstery surface of the MLW is made of PU (polyurethane), artificial leather or Ferrari Stamskin Top artificial leather.
- ❖ We recommend using suitable PROTECTIVE COVERS to keep the lying surface in good condition.
- ❖ See also chapter 22.4 PROTECTIVE COVERS
